

BIBLE INTERACTION TOOL EXERCISES

1 READ IN CONTEXT

Read the Bible more than one verse at a time! Read the entire chapter -- or better yet the chapter before and after your focus verse(s).

2 REPETITION

Don't let your time in the Bible be one-and-done. Reading a section of Scripture over and over again will help it sink in and new discoveries will be revealed!

3 MEDITATION

Give yourself some time to reflect on what you are reading. We are in a culture of more and more, faster and faster. Slow down and give the Spirit a chance to speak through your study.

4 FOLLOW CROSS REFERENCES

Following up on the cross references in your study Bible or through an online tool is like a treasure hunt that can lead you to new places in Scripture and a deeper understanding.

5 READ IN DIFFERENT TRANSLATIONS

Enrich your personal study by reading familiar texts in new translations. My favorites include ESV, NIV, NLT, and NASB.
