Bible

Read all of Paul's second letter to the Corinthians. Then focus your study and observations on chapters 1-4. Look for afflictions and reasons why Scripture says we should not lose heart. Record some Scriptures here to continue to explore.

Interact

Make observations as you read. Most often, this means I'm asking questions about the text. In the podcast, I talked about tracing "hope" through several verses. Pick up a pencil and jot down some notes as you study.

Tool

Complete a word study on "mercy" in 2 Corinthians 4:1. First, look up the word in the English dictionary. Next, use an online resource like BibleHub.com and choose the interlinear. Click on the word translated "mercy" & read and record the summary definitions. How does this change the way you read this verse?

Exercise

Challenge yourself to write a summary statement of ONE big idea from your study. Then share that big idea with a friend and encourage them to read 2 Corinthians for themselves, too!
