Bible

Start in a larger chunk of Scripture: 1 Thessalonians. Read/listen to the whole thing on repeat. Keep your antenna up for the times Paul either gives thanks or instructs us to give thanks.

Interact

Review the definition of the Greek word used in 1 Thessalonians 5:18 for "give thanks" -- *eucharisteo*. Use BibleHub.com or do a word study using [Logos Bible Software](#). Ponder how the additional information you've learned changes how you view this word in Scripture.

Tool

Explore the context of these times when Jesus *eucharisteo* (gave thanks). (I've given you the section where the word is used, but you should read and consider the full context.)

- Luke 22:17-19
- John 6:11-13, 23
- John 11:38-44

Exercise

Now that you've seen your Savior give thanks, it's your turn. Start a list today. Add to it daily. Be on the hunt for things to be thankful for. Nothing is inappropriate to give thanks for (except your self-righteousness...we see an example of that in Luke 18:11.)
